Applicants *must* meet the following criteria:

- Identify as Asian Pacific American;
- Current resident of San Mateo County;
- Intend to enroll in a college or university in the Fall 2024;
- Attend the in-person Scholarship Awards Ceremony on Saturday, May 18, 2024, from
   12-2pm in Foster City (exact location to be shared with applicants)

If any of these above conditions are not met, or if any part of the application is incomplete or any required documents are not submitted by the deadline (*received via email by 11:59pm, Friday, April 26*), the application will be disqualified. Applicants not attending college in Fall 2024 will also be disqualified and the award will be withdrawn. Applicants will be notified of their award status via email no later than 11:59pm, Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>.

The following criteria will be utilized in selecting the successful applicants:

- Financial need:
- Community service and volunteerism;
- Leadership and creativity;
- Academics

While financial need is a key consideration for the scholarships, other criteria such as community service and academic achievement will also be considered. Most of our successful applicants are among the top students in their class based on essays as well as grades and community service.

Applicants need to complete only one application to compete for all scholarships in our program. In prior years, we awarded 10+ scholarships and this coming year, we anticipate awarding at least 8+ scholarships of \$1,000 each.
